Desirable qualifications: expertise in one or more of the following: psychodynamic theory and practice, cognitive and/or projective assessment, psychopharmacology, biological bases of behavior, statistics.

DIRECTOR OF INTERNSHIP TRAINING POSITION: Responsibilities include: Assisting students apply for predoctoral internship; coordination and development of training relationships with appropriate internship sites locally, regionally, and nationally. The Director of Internship Training is also a faculty member and engages in some teaching, advising, supervision of student research, and mentoring in the M.A. and Psy.D. programs.
