After they are admitted to the program, students with previous graduate coursework in psychology may ask individual professors if the students' previous coursework qualifies them to waive similar Rutgers graduate courses. Up to 30 credits can be transferred in with permission, and applied toward Rutgers graduation requirements. Doing this may or may not reduce time to completion. In 2011-2012, students who entered with Masters' degrees graduated sooner. In 2012-13, they did not.

Financial Support
