The Rutgers School Psychology Internship Consortium is open to those doctoral students enrolled in the school psychology program at the Graduate School of Applied and Professional Psychology, Rutgers University that have met program requirements to apply for internship. All applicants must register to participate in the APPIC Internship Matching Program (the "Match") and participate in the National Matching Service. This includes abiding by the APPIC Match Policies, the Schedule of Dates of the Match, and the terms of Agreement when registering for the Match.
