**APPLICANTS FROM OTHER PROGRAMS WILL BE CONSIDERED AFTER THE SECOND ROUND OF OFFERS HAVE BEEN MADE IF THERE ARE REMAINING OPEN SLOTS.**

- **The Internship Panel** (For RU Consortium supervisors and students) will be held on **Monday, Nov. 14th, 2016**. The Panel will be held from 5:15pm – 7:30pm in Multipurpose Rm. A at the Busch Student Center.
- **APPLICATIONS:** may be submitted directly to the sites **between Monday, Feb. 6<sup>th</sup> & Friday Feb. 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017**. The deadline is Feb. 26th, 2017. Please submit completed applications as one packet, INCLUDING letters of Recommendation. Each site will distribute information on supervisor contact information and required application materials at the panel; this information will be also updated on the gsappweb and requirements may vary between the sites. - **INTERVIEWS:** will be conducted **from Wednesday, Mar. 1<sup>st</sup> – Friday, Mar. 24<sup>th</sup>, 2017**. Sites will arrange interviews directly with students. Selection of applicants to interview and the actual interviews are conducted by the sites without GSAPP faculty involvement.
- **First offers** will be made by sites to applicants on Monday, **Apr. 3<sup>rd</sup>, 2017**. Applicants are required to respond to any offer by the end of the day on Thursday, Apr. 6<sup>th</sup>.
- Second offers **will be made on Monday, Apr. 10<sup>th</sup>. Applicants must respond within 24 hours.**
- **Applicants from non-RU students** will be considered if any open slots remain.
